CSA Infoboard. Appeal to the Swiss passport holders in Australia!

Switzerland has a long tradition as a democratic country, and one of the characteristics of the Swiss system is that it is a participating democracy. That means, Swiss citizens are not only allowed to, but are encouraged to participate in the political process. We should keep in mind that the Swiss passport is not only a privilege but also encompasses civil duties and obligations. Real democracy only works if the citizens participate.

World wide, about 23.91% of the Swiss abroad have registered to vote but in Australia, the figure is only 14.35%. It looks as if the distance from Switzerland plays a certain role here in Australia. Distance from Switzerland however, is not an excuse, as voting information is readily available and is sent to each registered Swiss voter to his or her nominated address with sufficient background information on each subject which comes up for a Federal vote or election. An interesting website is always www.swissinfo.ch with current information.

It is fairly easy to register: either you contact your place of origin in Switzerland [Heimatort], or any of the local councils [Gemeinde] where you have been registered once in Switzerland [it does not have to be the last place of residence].

Swiss from abroad can make a difference, let's seize the opportunity!
